

Update on SGC Building Renovation Project



The SGC Renovation project will begin on Monday, July 8. We've been "clearing the closets", and moving day took place on Friday, June 28. THANK YOU EVERYBODY!

When the project begins, the SGC building, grounds, especially the patio, will become a construction site, and only contractors will have access to these areas. For clarity, this means:

- 1. There will be no access to taped-off areas and all surrounding grounds of the Sarasota Garden Club
- 2. There will be no parking in the SGC circle, as this area will be dedicated to construction vehicles only
- 3. There will be no access to the facility, for any reason. Restrooms, Great Room, Kitchen, Office Area, and Library are off-limits, basically, the entire building
- 4. There will be no access to the patio or shed
- 5. There will be no gardening for the duration of the construction project, <u>from Friday, June 28</u>, until Friday September 6

We know there is concern for the gardens during this time, so The Bay has arranged for Justin to go through the grounds frequently during this time checking on plants, irrigation, and watering plants as needed.

When we return to Sarasota Garden Club, it will be very nicely upgraded with the new sliding glass doors, windows, flooring, and walls painted. When you see anyone from The Bay, please thank them for all these wonderful upgrades beautifying the building. HERE'S THE BEFORE!

Members enjoyed a terrific tour of Marie **Selby Botanical Gardens Downtown** Campus on Tuesday June 11, organized by Carol Lackey/Programs, and led by Ashley Jimenez and Angel Lara.

We were excited to learn about the completion of Phase One of the Selby Master Plan from Ashley, and then tour the Entry Gardens and Conservatory with Angel.

Hearing about how the Horticulture staff interprets the theme of the current exhibit and designs and installs the plant material and props was fascinating. Such creativity and fun brought to the exhibit.

On our own we toured the grounds and we discovered the further designs that conveyed and linked to both Yayoi Kusama and Georgia O'Keefe artistry and design moda.

We were lucky that the rain held off for us as we headed for the Museum of Botany and The Arts to see prints, paintings, ephemera and much more of both artists and learn more about their connection and how Kusama was encouraged to pursue her passion.





Editor's Garden in England

Hello everyone. I live in Baywood Colony, Sarasota, 6 months a year, and the other half of the year I return to my home in <u>Bassingbourn</u>, near Cambridge in England.



In the UK, we have a house in the village, with a small/mediumsized garden, which I 'put to bed' in October, and am lucky enough to have somebody awaken it for me in April, one month before we return. Unfortunately, I miss the Spring flowers (daffodils, tulips, snowdrops etc.) but a focus of my garden is HOSTAS in pots, which do very well in my absence.



THIS YEAR, I had to remove an old, broken-down Pyracanthana (left) which, at about 8ft tall, had torn itself away from the wall fixings. Such a shame, because it was a haven for birds to shelter and nest in, and provided early blossoms for bees and bright orange berries for birds in the winter. It's being replaced with a Ceanothus (right) and another Pyracantha.





While I'm waiting for the above to grow, I've planted RUNNER BEANS that are growing by inches every day, and should be ready to harvest in about another month.

Americans are not too familiar with Runner Beans – they must be an English thing. (Left) is the size of the beans as they mature, and (Right) is what they look like against my wall right now>>>>

The red flowers will germinate to produce the beans, and they will go on and on for about 2 months! DELICIOUS!
