“Guided Tour of Marie Selby Botanical Gardens’ “Historic Spanish Point Campus”

We will enjoy a guided tour through 33 acres of bayfront sanctuaries on Little Sarasota Bay, which will focus on both local history and plant life.

Our tour will include visiting a turn-of-the-century pioneer homestead called the Guptill House, as well as a chapel, boatyard, gardens and nature trails.

This archaeological and historic site is listed on the U.S. National Register of Historical Places.

After the tour you can also take in the prehistoric shell mound (called a midden).
