

Review of September's General Members Meeting

The first General Meeting of the season was kicked off with the Selby Garden's President and CEO, **Jennifer Rominiecki**, giving an update on future enhancements to the Gardens.

April 1, 2022 – Marie Selby Botanical Gardens has received the permit to begin vertical construction on Phase One of the Master Plan for its Downtown Sarasota campus. In addition, an underground storm water vault, which already has been constructed, will capture and treat all storm water runoff that passes through the Phase One footprint.

Also, **Christopher Elenstar**, Senior Director for Gardens Horticulture at Marie Selby Botanical Gardens, gave an update on Renovation of the Native Plant Garden at Selby's Downtown Campus.



We are a mix of serious gardeners and keen enthusiasts, who work hard and we sure have a good time together.


Volunteer as a "Friday Morning Worker" at SGC



October is a month of change in South Florida.

- Usually in the middle of the month, cooler weather is coming in and rainy days will be slacking back again
- If your orchids need watering, do it early in the morning. As days are getting shorter, your orchids need to dry out quite a bit
- Vanda* orchids need full sun and the roots can still be watered every day
- Check your orchids to see if the bloom spikes have turned brown. If they have, they can be cut off

TASKS FOR OCTOBER

- Space plants to increase air circulation
- Move Dendrobiums*, Catasetums*, Calanthe* and other dormant plants to dry out in bright locations
- Reduce general fertilizers. (I prefer to do time-release fertilizer twice a year and I usually do this in January and July as this has always worked for me.)

Vanda	A genus in the orchid family, Orchidaceae. There are about 87 species, and the genus is commonly cultivated for the marketplace.	
Dendrobium	A genus of mostly epiphytic and lithophytic orchids in the family Orchidaceae.	
Catasetum A genus of showy epiphytic Orchids with 166 species		
Calanthe	Commonly known as Christmas orchids, is a genus of about 220 species of orchids in the family Orchidaceae


